 ins. in the ground; for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears
 a Nut Pine 8 ins. diam., *N21°E* 130 lks. dist.
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.
 a Nut Pine 12 ins. diam., *S73°E* 260 lks. dist.
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

Set a post 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the
 ground for closing cor. to secs. 1 and 2 marked
C. C., T. 10N R. 33E on S. S. 1 on *E* and
 S. 2 on *E* faces with 1 notch on *E* and 5
 notches on *W* faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. *S. E & W.*
 of post, 5½ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft.
 high, 4½ ft. base around post.
