

that all the corners of said survey have been established and perpetuated in strict accordance with the surveying manual, printed instructions, the special written instructions of the United States Surveyor-General for Nevada, and in the specific manner described in the field-notes, and that the foregoing are the true field-notes of such survey; and, should any fraud be detected, I will suffer the penalty of perjury, under the provisions of an Act of Congress, approved August 8, 1846.
