Latitude $38^{\circ}35' N$ Va. 17° East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles $\frac{1}{2}$ chs. I arrive at a point 49 lbs. N of Cor. to
Tps. 8 & 9 N. Rs. 35 & 36 E. from which corner I run
 $N 89^{\circ}57' W$ on a true line between sections 1 and 36

Descend

40.00 Set a Granite stone $1\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ x 8 ins. $1\frac{1}{2}$
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

114.00 Bottom of Ravine about 12 ft. deep course NW. and ascend

49.00 Enter Heavy nut pines

80.00 A. Nut pine 11 ins. diam., which I marked T. 9 N. S. 36
on N. E. R. 35 E. S. / on S. E. S. 2 on S. W.
and S. 35 on N. W. faces with 5 notches on N. and
1 notch on E. edges, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. each
sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth around tree.
