post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

49.00 Snow Creek 10 lks. wide, runs S.W

96.12 Intersect the 5th Standard Parallel North at a
point 9.16 chs. East of the Standard Cor. r.
Secs. 35 and 36 T. 26 N. R. 62 E

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly
in the ground, marked T 26 N R 62 E S C
on N S 36 on E and S 35
on W faces, with 1 notch on E and 5 notches
on W edges.

of post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft.
high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
