

Final Oath of U. S. Deputy Surveyor.

I Geo. W. Gause U. S. Deputy Surveyor do solemnly swear that in pursuance of instructions received from C. C. Powning U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada bearing date of the 15th day of Dec^r A.D. 1883, I have well faithfully and truly, in my own proper person, and in strict conformity with the instructions furnished by the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, the surveying Manual and the laws of the United States, surveyed all those parts or portions of the Exterior Boundaries of Township 2 North Range 34 East and of the Subdivision lines in Township 2 North Range 34 East and in Townships 2 and 3 North Range 36 East of the principal base and meridian in the State of Nevada as are represented in the foregoing field notes as having been surveyed by me and under my directions. And I do further solemnly swear that all the corners of said survey have been established and perpetuated in strict accordance with the surveying manual, printed instructions, the special written instructions of the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, and in the specific manner described in the Field notes, and that the foregoing are the true field notes of such survey, and should any fraud be detected I will suffer the penalty of perjury under the provisions of an act of Congress Approved August 8 A.D. 1846.
