 mound alongside. I run
 North on a true line between sections 32 & 33

Variation $17^{\circ}45'$ East.

Set a *Line* stone $2 \times 10 \times 10$ ins. 8
 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone.
 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33
 marked T. 36 N S. 28 on N. E., - R 36 E, S. 33
 on S. E., - S. 32 on S. W. and S. 29 on N. W. face
 with 1 notch - on S. and 4 notches on E. edges
 and raised a mound of stone 2 ft. high $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
 around post. Whence bears
