40.00 Set a Granite stone $9 \times 14 \times 12$ ins. 14 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears a Cedar 12 ins. diam., $N 26^{\circ} E 70$ lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

A Cedar 13 ins. diam., $S 22^{\circ} W 60$ lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

46.00 Cross Ravine Course NW

80.00 Set a Granite stone $20 \times 12 \times 7$ ins. 16 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 & 36 marked with / notch — on S. and / notch — on E. edges and dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base alongside Whence bears

A Nut Pine 12 ins. diam., $S 18^{\circ} E 40$ lks. dist. marked T37N R. 63ES., 36 B. T.

A Nut Pine 16 ins. diam., $S 28^{\circ} W 80$ lks. dist. marked T37N R. 63ES., 36 B. T.

A Cedar 8 ins. diam., $N 10^{\circ} W 72$ lks. dist. marked T37N R. 63ES., 26 B. T.
