Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T39N S36 on N. E., R. 63 E.

S. 1 on S. E. T38N S. 2 on S. W. and S36 on N. W. faces, with / notch - on E and S notch on W edges. 5 lb mound of earth

around post - from which cor. I run S. 6' E on a true line between sections 1 & 2 with same va

along west-slope of Ridge

3000 Enter timber line. NE to W

40.27 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.
