

Township 19 North <sup>62</sup> Range N. E. East-

Monte Diablo Base and Meridian

Survey Commenced  
May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1884. With a Burt  
improved Bovee Compass  
I begin at the corner to  
Section 5-6-31 & 32, on the  
North boundary of Township  
which is a stone  $16 \times 12 \times 6$  ins. in the ground  
marked with 1 notch on W and 5 notches on E edges  
and mound of stone - from which  
Cor. 0 run

South on a true line between sections 5 and 6  
Variation  $16^\circ$  East.

- Ascend along N slope of High Mountain
- 40.00 Set a Trap stone  $14 \times 12 \times 8$  ins. 10  
ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on W  
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
- 80.00 Set a Trap stone  $16 \times 14 \times 8$  ins. 11 ins. in  
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 5-6-7 and 8 marked  
with 6 notches on S. and 5 notches on E. edges and  
raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

Land worthless. Steep rocky  
slope of High Mountains.  
Sage brush and some scattering bunch grass  
Soil rocky and 372 rate.
