9.00 Descend 15° slope

9.80 Stream 6 fks. wide, runs East  
 and ascend 18° slope

21.00 Top of ridge f. E. and descend 25° slope

33.00 Stream 5 fks. wide, runs f. E.  
 and ascend 20° slope

40.00 Set a limestone stone 18 x 18 x 6 ins. 12  
 ins. in the ground. for  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on W  
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

72.00 Top of Ridge, bears f. E. and descend 14° slope

80.00 Set a Granite stone 22 x 16 x 12 ins. / 6 ins. in  
 the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25-30 31-36 marked  
 with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges and  
 raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
