80.00 Set a Sand. stone $1/4 \times 12 \times 7$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Tps. 13 and $1/4$ N R's 36 and 36 E marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

The necessary corrections corresponding to the given slopes has been applied and the corners located according to the true distance thus obtained
