Ascend 10° Slope

1000 Top of Ridge, bears N60°W + 36°E and descend 9° slope

2700 Bottom of Ravine about 20 ft. deep course 2W
 and ascend 8° slope

40.00 Set a Sand stone 16 x 12 x 7 ins. 11
 ins. in the ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on W
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

5300 Ascend 6° slope along W slope of ridge

80.00 Set a Sand stone 18 x 12 x 10 ins. 12 ins. in
 the ground for Cor. to Tps. 14 and 15 N E's 35 and 36°
 E marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a
 mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
