Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on *N* face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., *N* and *S* of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Set a post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. *11* and *12* *N* R's *32* and *33* *E*, marked T. *11* *N* S. 31, on N. E. R. *33* *E* S. 3, on S. E. T. *10* *N* S. 1 on S. W. and R. *32* *E* S. 36, on N. W. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
