- 40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- > 9.82 Intersect S + W line - 40 ins. W of cor. to secs 28, 29, 32 + 33. which is a stone 18 x 18 x 12 ins. marked with 1 notch - on S and 4 notches on E edges and mound of stone from which cor. I run 8^o N on a true line between sections 28, 29, 32 with same va Ascend 8^o slope
- 50.00 Top of Ridge, bears West. and descend 18^o slope
- 39.92 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., W and S of post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.
