Set a *Trap* stone 14 x 13 x 10 ins. 9 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on *W* face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

Top of Ridge, bears N.E. and descend 9° slope

Cross Ravine Course N^oW. and still descend 5° slope

Intersect the *Eighth* Standard Parallel North at a point 19,32 chs. East of the Standard Cor. to Secs 35 and 36 T. 41 N. R. 50 East. *W.M.* which is a stone 18 x 12 x 8 ins.marked *SC* with 1 notch on E and 3 notches on W edges and mound of stone at which point DSet a *Lim* stone 20 x 13 x 10 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs 3 and 4 marked C with 3 notches on E 6 notches on S² 3 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

The necessary corrections corresponding to the giving slope A has been applied and the corner A located according to the true distance thus obtained.
