- Chains.	North, on a true line between Sections 4 and 5. Variation $18^{\circ} 40'$ East.
28, 00	Descend 13° slope Ravine about 6 feet deep, course N.E.; and ascend 6° slope.
40.00	Set a <u>Slate</u> , stone $15 \times 10 \times .8$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
57, 00	Ascend 5° slope
72, 00	Top of Ridge, bears N.E., and descend 18° slope
102, 00	Ravine about 20 feet deep, course East and ascend 14° slope
144, 22	Intersect the <u>Dallett</u> Standard Parallel North at a dist. 19.36 chs. East of the Standard C. i.e. Sects. 34 and 35 T. 41 R. 50 E. which is a stone $12 \times 8 \times 6$ ins. marked S.C. with 2 notches on E and 4 notches on W edges and mound of stone - at which point Set a <u>final</u> stone $20 \times 14 \times 12$ ins. 13 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Sects. 4 and 5 - marked C C. with 4 notches on E & 2 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
	The necessary corrections corresponding to the giving slope & has been applied and the corners located according to the true distance thus obtained.
