ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on W
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

74.00 Descend 18° slope

101.00 Ravine about 20 feet deep, course N 15° W descends slope

123.00 Descends 10° slope from bears N 10° W

144.56 Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North at a
point 19.18 chs. East of the Standard Cor. to
Secs. 38 and 34. T. 41 N. R. 50 E. Inf. J. K.
which is a stone $14 \times 12 \times 10$ ins.

marked S.C. with 3 notches on W. and 3 notches on E. edges

and mound of stone - at point of intersection

Set a Prop stone $18 \times 18 \times 10$ ins. 12 ins. in the
ground for closing Cor. to Secs. 5 and 6 marked C
C. with 5 notches on E. 6 notches on S. 4 notches on W. edges,
and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

The necessary corrections corresponding
to the giving slope has been applied and
the corner located according to the true
distance thus obtained.
