Chains. From the Cor. to Sections 34 and 35. 273 on the S. boundary which is a stone, $9 \times 8 \times 7$ ins. marked with 4 notches on W and 2 notches on E edges and mound of stone

Run North between Secs. 34 & 35

Variation $170^{\circ} 30'$ East.

Over nearly level ground.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W face, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., N and S of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

26.10 Dry Channel 10 lks. wide, course S E

80.00 Set a lime stone $11 \times 11 \times 10$ ins. 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35 marked with 1 notch on S. and 2 notches on E. edges and dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base alongside
