

52 North boundary of
Township 46 NORTH Range 27 EAST

Monte Diablo Base and Meridian.

From the Cor. to Tps. 46 & 47 N Rs. 26. & 27 E
I run East on random line on N. B. of Tp.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles 78.10 chs. I arrive at a point 2/3 lks. S of Cor. to
Tps. 46 & 47 N Rs. 27 & 28 E

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set
in the ground, marked T. 46 N R 27 E 3 sec on S.W.
T 47 N 3 36 and the N.W. T 47 N 3 31 on the N.E. 1
& R 28 E. See 6 on S2 sides with 6
notches on each corner. The mound was
partially worked down & the pits filled up
& I restored mound & pits
from which Cor. I ran —

S 89° 45' W on a true line between sections 1 & 36

Variation 18½ East.

OVER level land

40. av Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone
12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on
N face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E and W of
post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

70. av Leave alluvial bottom & enter gradual sandy
slope course N $\frac{1}{4}$ S

80. av Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone,
12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35, 36
marked T. 47 N S. 36 on N. E., -R 27 E. S. S /
T 46 N on S. E., S. 2 on S. W. and S. 35 on N. W. face
with 5 notches on N. E. and 1 notch on N. W. edges
