 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4} S$ on
~~W~~ face, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., N and S of
 post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
 high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

90.00 Intersect the Fourth Standard Parallel North at a
 point 12,76 chs. East of the Standard Cor. to
 Secs. 31 and 36 T. 20 N Rgs 4, 9, 43 & 50 E. which is
 a post 4 ins square firmly set in the ground
 marked S.C. T. 20 N. on N R 50 E S 31 & 50 E
 and R 49 E S 36 on W faces with 6 notches
 on N & S faces and pits of $24 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. on E &
 E 49 of post & mound of earth around it. At this point
