40.00 Set temporary 1/4 sec. cor.

79.54 Intersect N. B. of Tp. 12 lks E of cor. to secs 4, 5, 8 & 9 which is a stone 12 x 8 x 7 ins.

marked with 2 notches on Wand 4 notches on Edges and mound of stone

from which cor. I run 50' E in a true line between sections 4 & 5 with same va Ascend 3° slope

38.40 Cross creek 5 lks wide in a Ravine about 30 feet deep, course N 10° E and ascend 5° slope

39.54 Set a line stone 18 x 10 x 6 ins. 1/2 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on W face, and raised a mound of stone along side. Pits impracticable.

57.00 Cross creek 5 lks wide in a Ravine about 30 feet deep, course N 10° W Ascend 5° slope

79.04 The cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8 & 9 The necessary corrections corresponding to the giving slope & has been applied and the corner located according to the true distance thus obtained.
