12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on  
(W) face, dug pits,  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins.  $N$  and  $S$  of  
post  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, around post.

80.00 Set a stone  $16 \times 10 \times 8$  ins. 11 ins. in  
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 13. 14. 23 + 24 marked  
with 3 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. edges and  
dug pits,  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins. in each Sec.,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist.,  
and raised a mound of earth  $2$  ft. high,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base  
alongside
