

Township 22 N Range 27 E



Monte Diablo Base and Meridian.

From the Cor. to Tps. 22 & 23 N Rs. 27 & 28 E

I run west on random line on N. B. of Tp.
Variation $17^{\circ}44'$ East.I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles 79.20 chs. I arrive at a point 194 lks. N. of Cor. to
Tps. 22 & 23 N Rs. 26 & 27 E.,
which is a stone 16 x 12 x 12 ins.marked with 6 notches on N. E. S. & W. edges
and mound of stone
from which cor. I run $N 89^{\circ} 46' E$

on a true line between sections 6 & 31 with same va.

Over nearly level ground

39.20 Set a Basalt stone 12 x 10 x 7 ins. 8
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

62.00 Dry Channel 20 lks. wide, course N 100

79.20 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone.
12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 5, 6, 31, 32
marked T. 23 N S. 32 on N. E., - R 272 S. 31
on S. E., $\overline{S. 6}$ on S. W. and S. 31 on N. W. face
with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on E. edges
Aug 18. 18 x 15 x 12 ins. in each Sec., 3 ft. dia.,
and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 ft. base
around post
