

From the Cor. to Tps. 27 & 28 N Rs. 29. & 30 E

I run East on random line on N. B. of Tp.

Variation $17\frac{3}{4}$ East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 6 -
miles 770 chs. I arrive at a point 3190^{Chs} N of Cor. to
Tps. 28 N & Rs. 30. & 31 E.

Set a frontstone 12 x 16 x 10 ins. 8 ins. in the
ground for Closing Cor. to Tps. 27+28. NR 30E marked C
C. with 6 notches on N. and 6 notches on S. edges
and raised a mound of stone alongside.

on a true line between sections 1 & 36 with same va

As and gradually

23.00 Dry Channel 20 fks. wide, courses 8 E

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone
12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on
N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E and W of
post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Ascend. 120 feet

62.00 ridge N & S - then along S. slope

80.00 Set a Basalt stone 15 x 10 x 10 ins. 10 ins. in
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35, 36 marked
with 5 notches on W and 1 notch on E. edges and
raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
