40.00 Set a line stone 12 x 10 x 9 ins. 8

46.00 Top of Ridge, bears N & S and descend 50 ft

60.00 Cross Ravine Course S and ascend 30 ft

80.00 Set a line stone 14 x 12 x 12 ins. 9 ins. in
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35, 36 marked
with 5 notch S on W and 1 notch on E. edges and
raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
