W. faces, with 2 notches on W and 4 notches on E edges. With pits & mound of earth from which cor. 1 run S. 13° E on a true line between sections 4 & 5 with same cor.

Set a Trap stone 12 x 10 x 10 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked N. W. face. Dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. North of stone $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base alongside.
