Ascend gradually

25.00 Dry Channel 20 fks. wide, course S.W.  
and ascend 75. Feet

39.00 Top of Ridge, bears S W and descend 10 feet

40.00 Set a Trap stone 16 x 12 x 10 ins. 12  
ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W  
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.  
descend 20 feet

62.00 A Spring bears on line Ascend. 75. Feet

67.00 Top of Ridge, bears S W and descend 30 Feet
