Chains

Preliminary to commencing this survey I ran N. on a blank line on the E. boundary of sec 36 and at 40 chs found the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec cor. and at 80 chs found the sec cor. I also ran West on a blank line on the South boundary of sec 36 and at 39.98 found the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec cor. and at 80 chs found the sec. cor. My compass will therefore run the same line as the exterior boundaries and the chaining practically agrees. Survey commenced June 14 1888 with an improved Solar Transit.

I commenced at the cor to secs 1.2. 35 & 36 on the south boundary of the Tp previously described by me.

Thence I run from this Cor, which is a Willow post  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2} \times 2$  ft - mark T3776. S36 on N.E. R39 E; D1 on S. E.

T3678: D2 on S.W. and

D35, on N.W. faces with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges. Pity in each face  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft - dia. and mound of earth around post,
