

Chains I therefore begin at the  
S. W. Tip cor which is a  
willow stick  $1" \times 1" \times 2$  ft  
marks nearly obliterated

Trace of mound and pits

Rebuilt this cor and re-established  
the cor as follows —

on Standard Line —

deposited marked stone 12 ins  
in ground for Tip cor  
dug pits  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins

$5\frac{1}{2}$  ft dist on E - W and N  
and raised a mound of earth  
2 ft high  $4\frac{1}{2}$  feet base over it  
In N pit drove a stake  
2 ins square - 2 ft long  
12 ins in ground marked  
T 36 N - S 31 SC on N E
