Chains

Preliminary to commencing this survey I ran a line on a blank line on the South boundary of Sec 33 and at 39.99 chs found the 1/4 sec cor and at 80 chs found the sec cor. My compass will therefore run the same line as the exterior boundary, and the chaining practically agrees.

Survey commenced July 13th 1888 with a Gurley Solar Transit.

I commenced at the cor. to Secs 3. 4 33 & 34 on the S. bdy of the Tp. which is a stone 18 x 10 x 6 ins firmly set in the ground, with 3 matches on E & W. edges with trace of pits in each sec 5 1/2 ft dist and mound of stone and earth 2 ft high 4 1/2 ft base alongside.
