Chain

On the night of July 25th 1888. I took an observation on the star Polaris in accordance with instructions contained in the Manual of Surveys and drove pickets on the line thus established. Survey commenced July 26th 1888 with a Sully Solar Transit and a Steel Chain. Before commencing this survey I test my compass on the line established last night and find it correct.

Having retraced the E bdy of the Tp and only found one cor. on the line I reservey the same in order to close my work of subdivision on it.

I begin at the cor to Tps 36 & 37 N. R's 37 & 38 E. which is a stone 11. x 7 x 5 ins firmly set in the ground with 6 notches on N. S. E & W edges, surrounded by a small mound of
