

7<sup>th</sup> Standard Parallel North through Range 32 E

On the night of Nov. 29<sup>th</sup> 1888 I took an observation on the Star Polaris in accordance with instructions contained in the Manual of Survey, and drove pickets on the line thus established. Survey commenced Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 1888 with a Swley's improved solar compass and 2 properly tested steel chains. Before commencing this survey I test my compass on the line established last night and find it correct.

I begin at the Standard Corner to Tpo 36 N. Range 32 & 33 E. already described by me

Thence I run

West on S bdy of Sec 36

Var  $17^{\circ}55'E$

Over level ground

40.00 Deposit a charred stake 12 ins in the
