

Humboldt River Guide N^o 737 N.

On the night of Sept. 4th 1888 I took an observation on the Star Polaris, in accordance with Instructions contained in the manual of surveys & driven pickets on the line thus established. Survey commenced Sept. 5th 1888 with a Goodley Solar Transit & Steel Chain.

Before commencing this survey I took my compass on the line established last night & find it correct.

I begin at the cor. to Tps. 36 & 37 N.
Rs 35 & 36 E already described, & run North bet. sees. 31 & 36.

Var 18° 00' E,

52.00 Road in pass bet. E & W.

40.00 Found traces of old mon. of stone but no marks. I set rock 18 x 12 x 3 ins 13 ins in ground for 4 sec. cor. mark 4 on N face & raised a round stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
