

Exteriors T 36 N. R 34 E.

On the night of Oct 22<sup>d</sup> 1888 I took an observation on the Star Polaris in accordance with the instructions contained in the Manual of Surveys and drove pickets on the line thus established. Survey commenced Oct 23<sup>d</sup> 1888 with a Gurley's improved Solar instrument and properly treated Steel chain.

Before commencing this survey I test my compass on the line established last night and find it correct.

x I begin at the Standard Cor to Tps 36 N. R's 33 & 34 E previously described by me

Thence I run

North bet Secs 31 & 36

Var.  $17^{\circ}45'$  E.

Over level ground

Deposit a charred stake 12 ins in the ground
