Survey commenced Nov. 2nd 1888. with a Gurley Solar Transit & Steel chain.

Before commencing this survey I test my Inst. on the line established last night & find it correct.

✕ I begin at the cor. to Tps. 36 & 37 N. R. 33 & 34 E. and run North on the West boundary of T37 N R34 E.
