37 to 44  
 chains On the night of Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> 1888  
 I take an observation on Star Polaris  
 in accordance with instructions  
 contained in the "Manual of Surveys"  
 & drive pickets on the line thus  
 established.

Survey commenced Sept 5<sup>th</sup> /88  
 with a Gurley's Solar Transit &  
 steel chain.

Before commencing the survey I  
 set my wish on the line established  
 the previous night & find it correct.

From the cor. to Tps. 37 & 38 N.  
 R. 35 & 36 E on Humboldt River  
 Guide Meridian I run east on a  
 random line bet. said Tps. the  
 var. of my compass being  $18^{\circ}$  E  
 I set temporary half mile & mile cors. at  
 every 40 & 80 chs. & find the line to be.
