

## Subdivisions of T. 38 N. R. 46 E. 40

Chains I now return to cor. of sect. 24<sup>40</sup> and C  
 19, 25<sup>40</sup> 30, whence mouth of  
 rock creek cañon bears S 25° 32' E  
 about 40 chs. <sup>40</sup> run west on a  
 true line bet. sect. 24<sup>40</sup> 25.

Var. 17° 40' E.

Over table land, shows a little  
 alkali.

40.00 Set a post 4 ft. long 4 x 3 inc. for  
 1/4 cor. marked 1/4 S on E face; dug  
 pits E. <sup>40</sup> W. of cor. 5 1/2 ft. dist. <sup>40</sup>  
 raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high  
<sup>40</sup> 4 1/2 ft. base around post.

56.80 Creek 60 lks. wide, course S. E. changes  
 to E. in about 25 chs.

59.40 Marshy ground. From this point  
 a pond bears N 1 ch. 20 lks.

70.00 Out of marshy ground.

80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long 4 x 3 inc. for  
 cor. to sects. 24<sup>40</sup> 25, 25<sup>40</sup> 26.
