

Survey of Ft. Huellock
Hay Reservation,

Sept 19th 1890.

Not being able to identify
any points on the
boundaries of the reserva-
tion, I go to the clos-
ing-cor. on the "7th
Standard", bet. secs 3
and 4 T. 35 N., R. 58 E.,
which is a stone 11x10x
7 ins above ground,
with 3 nothes on E. and
3 nothes on W. edges,
marked C. C.; with pits
18x18x12 ins S. E. & W. of
stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.; mound
of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft
base alongside.
