After diligent search being unable to find any trace of old corner set a Redwood Post 4 ft. long 4 ins. square, with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. Co. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, dug pile 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E $\frac{3}{8}$ N. of Post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. $\frac{3}{8}$ raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
