Revising July 15th 1893 at the corner common to Secs. 3. 4. 9 + 10 which is a mound with pits and post lying on the ground with marks nearly obliterated.

I re-establish this corner as follows at the same point;

Set a post 4 ft. long 4 ins. square 12 ins. in the ground for corner to secs 3. 4. 9 + 10 marked,

T. 33 N. S. 3 on N.E.

R. 47 E. S. 10 on S.E.

S. 9 on S.W. and

S. 4 on N.W. faces with 5 notches on S. and 3 on E. edges, dug pits 24 x 24 x 12 inches in each section
