

Exteriors T. 34 N. R. ⁶⁰ E. M. D. M.

Beginning Aug. 29th 1898 at the corner to
Tps. 34 + 35 N. R. 60 E. (W. W. cor.) as establish-
ed by me & run S. on a blank line

between ranges 59 + 60 with Va. 17° 30' E.
and find no trace of any of the old corners
but that the corner to Tps. 33 + 34 N.
R. 60 E. (S. W. cor.) is S. of the starting
corner 5 miles 79 chs. 50 lks. As Tps.
34 N. R. 60 E. has not been subdivided
& consequently no sectional lines
closed on this N. bdy. I therefore re-
survey the same as follows.

From the corner to Tps. 33 + 34 N. R.
60 E. (S. W. cor.) which is a rock firmly
set & properly marked as per notes of
Surveyor General Dammitt on Range line.
Va. 17° 30' E.

950. closing corner to Tps. 33 + 34 N. R. 59
- 4000 Set a rock 16 x 10 x 6 inches 11 inches
in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$
on N. face and raised a mound
of stone 2 ft high 4 ft base
alongside. Pits impracticable.
