4000 Set cottonwood post $3 \times 3 \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ 12 in ground
for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec cor marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face
Dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ N. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ distant.
Raised mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high 4 ft
base around post.

4800 descend.

5800 dry chl s. W. ~~ascend~~

6100 Grad to coils N.W. dry chl SW. ascend

7400 descend

7600 dry chl s. E. Ascend

8000 Set cedar post $4 \times 4 \times 3$ 12 in ground
for corner to sections 25. 26. 35 & 36 marked
S. 22 N. S. 25 on N.E. R. 49 E S. 36 on S.E.
S. 35 on S.W. & S. 26 on N.W. faces
with 1 notch on East & South edges.

Dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ in each section 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ distant
Raised mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ high 4 ft base around
post.

Land undulating Dense sage & ochs.
Soil sandy & gravelly 2nd rate
No timber
