63.00 enter bench

80.00 set cedar post 4" sq. 4 ft. long 12" in ground for cor. to Secs 26. 26. 36. marked S. 17 N. S. 23 N. & E. R. 30 E. S. 36 N. S. E. S. 35' N. S. W. and S. 26 N. N. W. face
