

South Boundary Sp. 17 N. R. 51 E.

At 8 p.m. June 23rd 1893 I find by observation on the line run by one for the east boundary of Sp. 17 N. R. 51 E. to be $16^{\circ}40'$ E.

From the corner common to Sp. 16 & 17 N. Rs. 51 & 52 E I run N. 89.54° W on a blank line along the south boundary of Section 36 with $N. 16^{\circ}40'$ E and at

39 chs. 88 links find old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to be 16 links north and at 79.90 find the sec. cor. to be 17 links north. I therefore continue on the line and at 5 miles 79 chs and 88 links find the corner to Sp. 16 & 17 N. Rs. 50 & 51 E to be S. 1 ch. 68 links

As Sp. 16 N. R. 51 E has not been subdivided and consequently no subdivision lines have been closed on this south boundary I therefore resurvey the same as follows.

From the corner to Sp. 16 & 17 N. Rs. 50 & 51 E I run N. 89.54° E between Secs 31 & 36 with $N. 16^{\circ}40'$ E.
