

Fifth Standard Parallel N. through Range 34 East.

8000 Set a post 4 ft. long 4 inches square
with marked stone 24 inches in the
ground for ^{standard} corner to Tps. 26 N. Rs. 34
+ 35 E marked

S. 6 E. 26 N on N.

R. 35 E. S. 31 on E ^{and}

R. 34 E. S. 36 on W. with 6 grooves on
N. & W. faces, dug pit crosswise
on line 4 ft. E & W + N. 8 ft. distant
from post and raised a mound of
earth 2 ft. high 4 ft. base around
post.

At this point I find old standard
corner which is a ^{small} rock firmly set
in the ground & properly marked
as described in the field notes
furnished by the surveyor general.
This rock being smaller than called for
I use it for marked stone as above described.
