North Standard North

Being unable to find the S.W. Cor
Sp 21 N R 50 E. As the only
corners I could find along the
Nth Standard North being in
such a delapidated condition as to
render them difficult to identify
I go to the S.E. Cor 21 N R
50 E which is a cedar post
set in mound of earth properly
marked & witnessed by run
mesh along the Nth Standard
Parallel North.

Mesh on S. boundary Sec. 36
Nor. 16 45 E

4.000 Land level dense sage brush
a point $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. N. of old 1/4 sec
cor which was a mound of earth
with pits E & W. no trace of
post. I set a cedar post
3' off 1/4 N long in old mound
marked 1/4 S on N face. cleaned
pits & raised a mound of earth
7/8 high 1/4 base around post
70.50 under alkaline land. eye grass
leave sage brush.

Found old cor, which is a post 1/4 off
set in the ground no pits or
