

# General Description

Nearly  $5\frac{1}{2}$ <sup>ths</sup> of this township is mountainous & affords good grazing while the remainder in the western portion is bottom land well adapted to agriculture if irrigated.

It is watered by springs & by Trout, Bishop & Johnson Creeks.

Inclosures have been made & farming carried on in Secs. 7, 28, 30 & 32.

There is some scattering scrub juniper in the west half of the township.

All posts used are of redwood.
