temporary stake. I then started from the corner common to sections 18^{Es} 19 T 41. N R 35 E on the west boundary and ran north finding all the section and 1/4 section corners and at 3 miles intersect the line run by me for the north boundary of T 41 N R 35 E at the place set for temporary corner. I found traces of an old corner at this point. which is subject to over flow. being on the line between the grease wood and river bottom as described in the field notes supplied to me & therefore set the 1/4 corner at this point. as follows. Set a cottonwood post 3 ft long ^{with marked stone} 4 ins sq. 24 ins in the ground for corner to T 41 E 2 N. R. 34^{Es} 35 E. marked
