

South Boundary L. 43 N. R. 63 E.

In my first Survey of this Township I was unable to find the corner common to Secs. 32 and 33 on the S line of the Township from which corner I was instructed to run & therefore commenced my old survey and the present one from the corner to Secs 31 and 32 on the South boundary which is a willow stake properly marked set in a mound of earth with pits in each Sec. Thence I run East over rolling ground on South line Sec 32.

Ascend gently

descend

dry channel. course N. ascend

34.00

enter dense undergrowth of sage brush

4.00

found 1/4 Sec corner as set by me in good condition. this is a cottonwood post 3 ft. long 3 ins. square. with marked stone. Set 24 in in the ground, marked 1/4 S on N. face with pits 18 x 18 x 17 E. & W. 3 ft distant. and a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft base 1 1/2 ft high.
