

Eighth Standard Parallel North. through R. 57

Survey commenced June 19th 1896; and executed with a W & L. E. Gurley Transit. with Solar Attachment; which latter was not used. in running any lines of this Survey, double fore and back sights. being specifically directed on the Parallels, and used also on the Guide Meridian.

Solar adjusted. on true meridian. as found by Polaris observation. at corner of T. S. 40 N. R. S. 57 & 58 E.; and transit. adjusted.

Previously to commencing this survey, to find cor. to T. S. 41 N., R. S. 57 & 58 E., triangulated. from cor. to T. S. 39 & 40 N., R. 55 E. readily found, from field notes, near Alexander P. O., to point on a creek described. as intersected by W. City.

of T. 40 N. R. 58 E.. Scattering men on search for corners, the first cor. found. was cor. to Secs. 5. 6. 7 & 8, T. 40 N., R. 58 E. Thence I run N. 1. mile; finding $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. but no trace of closing cor.; thence W. expecting to find

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
